4. Fly Tying

- Steve's DRC Bug - Hook Size 14

- Give 3 reasons barbless hooks are used on Dry Run Creek

5. Fly Rod Preparation

- Using a Regular Fly Rod with backing, fly line and leader, add:
 - tippet
 - strike indicator
 - fly to tippet
 - split shot
- Using a Tenkara Rod with fly line, swivel and strike indicator, add:
 - leader / tippet
 - fly to tippet
 - split shot

6. On Dry Run Creek Learn the Water Quality requirements for trout in regard to:

- Temperature range
- pH range
- Dissolved oxygen range

7. On Dry Run Creek learn different creek sections, what trout are likely to be doing and methods to fish in the sections.
